5. What does Jesus’ response to the death of his friend Lazarus in John 11 tell us about his ability to relate to us? How can this benefit us when we need it the most?
6. Nobody is immune to the pain of death or grief. What things have you applied in such times that helped carry you through that you could share with the group?
