Discussion and Questions:

1. Can anyone tell of a time when you did “go”? Did you get bold and speak about the good news? Or tell of the time someone shared the good news with you. After all, it is why you are here.
2. An ambassador is someone who is an accredited representative sent by a foreign country to promote a specific place. They do not belong there but only stay for a while. Paul describes followers of Jesus as ambassadors in 2 Corinthians 5:20. What could your life look like if you believed that we are just representatives passing through this world? Would anything change?

4. Mat gave four tips to be a good ambassador.
 - KNOW who we represent. How well do you think we have to know Jesus before we can speak about him?
 - LEARN from those whom God has placed with you. What have you been passing on to others lately?
 - Lead with ACTIONS. Is your life worth imitating? (1 Thess 1:5) Why or why not?
 - Be prepared with WORDS.
