Discussion and Questions:

1. If you were to make a list of words that described Jesus, what would it contain? Why did you choose those words?
2. Why do you think people tend to focus on the more feminine/passive traits to Jesus and not His masculinity?
3. Artists often portray Jesus as a handsome, gentle Caucasian figure despite him being born in the Middle East. Movies choose a perfect specimen to play Christ. But the Bible gives us a wee indication regarding his physical appearance. Look up Isaiah 53:2-3. How might this alter the images you have of Jesus in your head?
4. Clint gave us three examples of Christ behaving in less than “meek and mild” ways. (John 2:13-17, Luke 9:51 and Matthew 27:27-31) Discuss how including these in our view of the human Jesus can increase his relatability to all people.
5. So far, we have dwelt on the human aspects of Christ. But what about His divinity? How is it possible that He can be fully God and fully man simultaneously? On what do you base your answer?
Use passages such as Hebrews 1:1-4, Colossians 1:16-20 and Revelation 1:1-8 if you need help.
6. Depending on the choice you have made, why do you follow Jesus, or why don't you? Do you think inaccurate or incomplete views of the true character of Christ have affected the degree to which you respond to Him? What changes can you make to address this?
