5. The two examples James uses to illustrate his point of faith in action, Abraham and Rahab are mentioned in the "Hall of Faith" chapter (see Hebrews 11:8-19 & 31). How is faith defined in Hebrews 11:1? What evidence did they give of their faith?
6. How would the world be different if every Christian demonstrated authentic faith as James describes it?
