Introduction to Ephesians

Ephesians 4:17-24

17 So I tell you this, and insist on it in the Lord, that you must no longer live as the Gentiles do, in the futility of their thinking.**18** They are darkened in their understanding and separated from the life of God because of the ignorance that is in them due to the hardening of their hearts. **19** Having lost all sensitivity, they have given themselves over to sensuality so as to indulge in every kind of impurity, and they are full of greed. **20** That, however, is not the way of life you learned **21** when you heard about Christ and were taught in him in accordance with the truth that is in Jesus. **22** You were taught, with regard to your former way of life, to put off your old self, which is being corrupted by its deceitful desires; **23** to be made new in the attitude of your minds; **24** and to put on the new self, created to be like God in true righteousness and holiness.

• Paul's Clear Message - Do not be like them!

Our Current Cultural Context & Narrative

- What is the narrative?
- Secularism, radical individualism, and making our own meaning and truth.

Definitions

- <u>Secularism</u> a worldview that started as an erasing of God from any public sphere.
- <u>Humanism</u> the idea that humans can be good without religion, and without God.
- <u>Radical individualism</u> the view that the freedoms and desires of each individual is above the collective.
- <u>Expressive individualism</u> In this view you are not only encouraged to fulfill any all desires you have, you are also encouraged to pursue and express your authentic self.
- <u>Authentic self</u> your identity based on your internal thoughts and feelings. No one outside of you can define you.
- <u>Existentialism</u> you make up your own meaning and purpose in this life, there is no greater purpose.
- What is the gospel or the good news in this worldview and how is it holding up?

Paul's prayer for the Ephesians:

Ephesians 1:17-23

17 I keep asking that the God of our Lord Jesus Christ, the glorious Father, may give you the Spirit of wisdom and revelation, so that you may know him better. **18** I pray that the eyes of your heart may be enlightened in order that you may know the hope to which he has called you, the riches of his glorious inheritance in his holy people, **19** and his incomparably great power for us who believe. That power is the same as the mighty strength **20** he exerted when he raised Christ from the dead and seated him at his right hand in the heavenly realms, **21** far above all rule and authority, power and dominion, and every name that is invoked, not only in the present age but also in the one to come. **22** And God placed all things under his feet and appointed him to be head over everything for the church, **23** which is his body, the fullness of him who fills everything in every way.'
