

• Your **3 enemies**: Your flesh, the world and Satan... will always be there.

<sup>7</sup> "When a servant comes in from plowing or taking care of sheep, does his master say, 'Come in and eat with me'? <sup>8</sup> No, he says, 'Prepare my meal, put on your apron, and serve me while I eat. Then you can eat later.' <sup>9</sup> And does the master thank the servant for doing what he was told to do? Of course not. <sup>10</sup> In the same way, when you obey me you should say, 'We are unworthy servants who have simply done our duty.'" Luke 7-10 NLT
