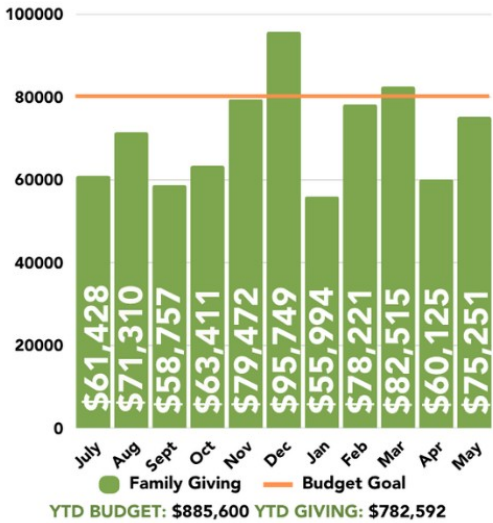

1. THE IDENTITY CRISIS

Our culture searches for identity in success, relationships, appearance, possessions, careers, performance, and the approval of others. But these foundations are temporary and will never satisfy the deep longing of the soul.

- Success fades.
- Relationships disappoint.
- Feelings change.
- Public approval shifts.
- Health declines.



When our identity is built on temporary things, our lives become unstable because our identity becomes uncertain.
