## ❖ Genesis, Exodus, Leviticus, Numbers and Deuteronomy

<sup>1</sup> The LORD said to Moses, <sup>2</sup> “Tell the Israelites to bring me an offering. You are to receive the offering for me from everyone whose heart prompts them to give. <sup>3</sup> These are the offerings you are to receive from them: gold, silver and bronze; <sup>4</sup> blue, purple and scarlet yarn and fine linen; goat hair; <sup>5</sup> ram skins dyed red and another type of durable leather; acacia wood; <sup>6</sup> olive oil for the light; spices for the anointing oil and for the fragrant incense; <sup>7</sup> and onyx stones and other gems to be mounted on the ephod and breastpiece. <sup>8</sup> “Then have them make a sanctuary for me, and I will dwell among them. <sup>9</sup> Make this tabernacle and all its furnishings exactly like the pattern I will show you.

### **Community Group Questions:**


1. Read: Exodus 25:8–9. Why did God want a sanctuary built? What does it look like for God’s presence to be central in your life today?


