For even the Son of Man came not to be served but to serve others and to give His life as a ransom for many."

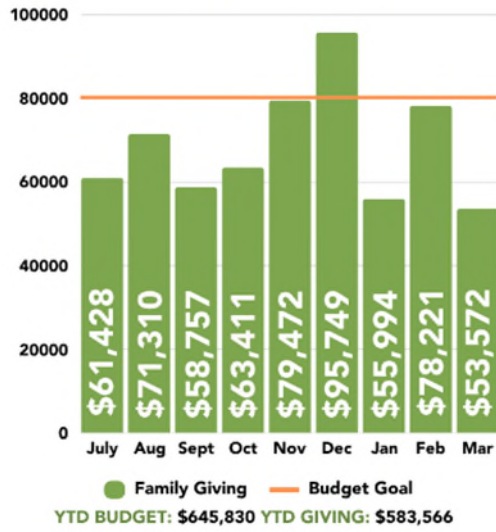
Mark 10:45 (NLT)

1. “Father, forgive them...” Luke 23:34
  - ❖ The First Work – Forgiveness
2. “Today you will be with me in paradise...” Luke 23:43
  - ❖ The Second Work – Heaven Opened
3. “Here is your son... Here is your mother...” John 19:26,27
  - ❖ The Third Work – Compassion & Care
4. “My God, My God, why have You forsaken Me...” Mark 15:34
  - ❖ The Fourth Work – Jesus was abandoned so we will never be abandoned
5. “I Thirst” John 19:28
  - ❖ The Fifth Work – Jesus becomes thirsty to satisfy our thirst with Living Water – the Holy Spirit
6. “It Is Finished” (TETELESTAI) John 19:30
  - ❖ The Sixth Work - All your sin debt is forever paid for
7. “Father, into your hands I commit my spirit.” Luke 23:46
  - ❖ The Seventh Work – you have eternal Access, Adoption, and Adventure

### **Community Group Questions**

1. What impacted you from the message on Jesus’ seven words and seven works from the cross?
2. Read Luke 23:34. Why is forgiveness our greatest need? Do you find it easy or hard to receive God’s forgiveness?
3. Read Luke 23:42–43. What stands out about the thief’s faith? How confident are you that you will be in paradise (heaven) after your earthly life is completed?
4. Read John 19:26–27. What does this show about Jesus’ care for His mother? How have you seen Him care for you?
5. Read Mark 15:34 and Hebrews 13:5,6. Why was Jesus forsaken? How does it make you feel that you will never be forsaken or abandoned by God?
6. Read John 19:28 and John 7:37-39. What does “I thirst” show us about Jesus? How does He satisfy your spiritual needs?
7. Read John 19:30. What does “It is finished” mean? How can you apply this in your life?
8. What does it mean that you have access, adoption, and an eternal adventure with Almighty God because of what Jesus did for you at the cross?
9. Which word and work of Jesus on the cross speaks to you most right now, and how can it help you with the current challenges you are facing?
10. Pray for family and friends to encounter the Lord this Easter weekend.
