- ➢ God's Good Creation

Then God said, "Let Us make man in Our image, according to Our likeness; and let them rule over the fish of the sea and over the birds of the sky and over the cattle and over all the earth, and over every creeping thing that creeps on the earth." God created man in His own image, in the image of God He created him; male and female He created them. God blessed them; and God said to them, "Be fruitful and multiply, and fill the earth, and subdue it.... God saw all that He had made, and behold, it was very good.

Gen. 1:26-28, 31a

Then the LORD God formed man of dust from the ground, and breathed into his nostrils the breath of life; and man became a living being [soul]. The LORD God planted a garden toward the east, in Eden; and there He placed the man whom He had formed. Out of the ground the LORD God caused to grow every tree that is pleasing to the sight and good for food; the tree of life also in the midst of the garden, and the tree of the knowledge of good and evil.... Then the LORD God took the man and put him into the garden of Eden to cultivate it and keep it.

Genesis 2:7-9, 15 (NASB)

Genesis 2:16, 17 (NASB)

Then the LORD God said, "It is not good for the man to be alone; I will make him a helper suitable for him.... So the LORD God caused a deep sleep to fall upon the man, and he slept; then He took one of his ribs and closed up the flesh at that place.

Genesis 2:18, 21 (NASB)

"Ezer" – a strong and effective helper; often used of Yahweh as Israel's helper

The Lord God fashioned into a woman the rib which He had taken from the man, and brought her to the man.

Genesis 2:22 (NASB)

The man said, "This is now bone of my bones, and flesh of my flesh; she shall be called Woman, because she was taken out of Man." Therefore shall a man leave his father and his mother, and shall cleave unto his wife: and they shall be one flesh. And the man and his wife were both naked and were not ashamed.

Genesis 2:23-25 (NASB)

Deception, Disobedience, Distortion, Alienation, and Death from rejecting God's Design and Plan – Genesis 3

Now the serpent was more crafty than any beast of the field which the LORD God had made. And he said to the woman, "Indeed, has God said, 'You shall not eat from any tree of the garden'?"When the woman saw that the tree was good for food, and that it was a delight to the eyes, and that the tree was desirable to make one wise, she took from its fruit and ate; and she gave also to her husband with her, and he ate. Then the eyes of both of them were opened, and they knew that they were naked; and they sewed fig leaves together and made themselves loin coverings.

By the sweat of your face you will eat bread, till you return to the ground, because from it you were taken; for you are dust, and to dust you shall return."

Genesis 3:16, 19 (NASB)

- Grace, Sacrifice, and Covering
- Restoration through Christ

Do not be drunk with wine, which will ruin you [is debauchery/reckless living], but be filled with the Spirit.... Yield [Submit; Be subject; yielding/submitting] to each other out of reverence [respect; fear; awe] for Christ. Wives, yield to [submit to; be subject to; to] your husbands, as you do to the Lord, because the husband is the head of the wife, as Christ is the head of the church. And he is the Savior of the body, which is the church. As the church yields [submits; is subject] to Christ, so you wives should yield [submit; be subject] to your husbands in everything [Col. 3:18; 1 Pet. 3:1–6]. Husbands, love your wives as Christ loved the church [Col. 3:19; 1 Pet. 3:7] and gave himself for her to make her holy [sanctify her], cleansing her in the washing of water by the word.
