

"The Church: God's Dwelling Place" Ephesians 2:21-22 Pastor Gary Barber

- Review The cross removes the walls/barriers/hostility between Jews and the Nations/Gentiles
- God is now building a <u>New Living Temple</u> made of "Living Stones"

Jesus Christ Himself being the chief cornerstone, in whom the whole building, being fitted together, grows into a holy temple in the Lord, in whom you also are being built together for a dwelling place of God in the Spirit. Ephesians 2:20b-22 (NKJV)

Jesus Christ Himself being chief corner-[stone], in whom all the building fitly framed together doth increase to an holy sanctuary in the Lord, in whom also ye are builded together, for a habitation of God in the Spirit. Ephesians 2:20b-22 (YLT)

We are a Holy Sanctuary "Hagios Naos"

Jesus, the Anointed Himself, the precious cornerstone. The building is joined together stone by stone all of us chosen and sealed in Him, rising up to become a holy temple in the Lord. In Him you are being built together, creating a sacred dwelling place among you where God can live in the Spirit.

Ephesians 2:20b-22 (VOICE)

Don't you understand that together you form a temple to the living God and His Spirit lives [in] you? If someone comes along to corrupt, vandalize, and destroy the temple of God, you can be sure that God will see to it that he meets destruction because the temple of God is sacred. You, together, are His temple. I Corinthians 3:16, 17 (VOICE)

The secret that hath been hid from the ages and from the generations, but now was manifested to His saints, to whom God did will to make known what [is] the riches of the glory of this secret among the nations -- which is Christ in you, the hope of the glory. Colossians 1:26, 27 (YLT)

 - Prayer, Reflection, Preparation for the Lord's Supper

I tell you the truth; unless you eat the flesh of the Son of Man and drink His blood, you will not know life. If you eat My flesh and drink My blood, then you will have eternal life and I will raise you up at the end of time. My flesh and blood provide true nourishment.
