But I will restore you to health and heal your wounds, declares the LORD. Jeremiah 30:17 (NIV)

❖ The Messiah's Mission Statement

The Spirit of the Lord is upon me, because he has anointed me to preach the gospel to the poor [afflicted]; he has sent me to heal the brokenhearted, to preach deliverance to the captives, and recovering of sight to the blind, to set at liberty them that are bruised, to preach the acceptable [favorable] year of the Lord. Luke 4:18, 19 (KJV Updated)

The Messiah Will Bring:

- Good news to the poor (afflicted)
- Healing for the brokenhearted
- Deliverance (freedom) for the captives
- Recovery of sight to the blind
- Liberation to the bruised
- An era of grace

❖ How can we be healed of our wounds?

In our time with Jesus, as we interact with Him transparently, we can experience healing from our wounds.

➤ By Jesus' wounds our wounds can be healed

Surely he took up our pain and bore our suffering, yet we considered him punished by God, stricken by him, and afflicted. But he was pierced for our transgressions, he was crushed for our iniquities; the punishment that brought us peace was on him, and by his wounds we are healed. Isaiah 53:4,5 (NIV)

“He himself bore our sins” in his body on the cross, so that we might die to sins and live for righteousness; “by his wounds you have been healed.” I Peter 2:24

❖ How Jesus wants to redeem and use your wounds

Jesus wants to do even more than heal you. He wants to redeem and repurpose your wounds to make you a compassionate and effective instrument to bring His healing to others.

And we know that in all things God works for the good of those who love him, who have been called according to his purpose. Romans 8:28 (NIV)

God does not waste your pain. He redeems it, transforming it into a platform to bring hope and healing to others while preparing you to fulfill the purpose He has for your life.
