

## **7-7-2024 – Hey Jude! What was that about Moses body???**

### **Jude 1 verse 8 (New Living Translation)**

<sup>8</sup> In the same way, these people—who claim authority from their dreams—live immoral lives, defy authority, and scoff at supernatural beings.

**New King James Version** - Likewise also these dreamers defile the flesh, reject authority, and speak evil of dignitaries.

**King James Verson** - Likewise also these filthy dreamers defile the flesh, despise dominion, and speak evil of dignities.

**New International Version** - In the very same way, on the strength of their dreams these ungodly people pollute their own bodies, reject authority and heap abuse on celestial beings.

**New American Standard Bible** - Yet in the same way these people also, dreaming, defile the flesh, reject authority, and speak abusively of angelic majesties.

**English Standard Version** - Yet in like manner these people also, relying on their dreams, defile the flesh, reject authority, and blaspheme the glorious ones.

**The Message** - This is exactly the same program of these latest infiltrators: dirty sex, rule and rulers thrown out, glory dragged in the mud.

**First part is talking about sexual sin – defile the flesh...pollute their own bodies.....**

**2<sup>nd</sup> part is about defying authority (from scripture – correction from scripture; correction from God)**

**3<sup>rd</sup> part - ?? - the major translations say “scoff at supernatural beings”, “speak evil of dignitaries”, “speak evil of dignities”, “heap abuse on celestial beings”, “speak abusively of angelic majesties”, “blaspheme the glorious ones”, and “glory dragged in the mud”**

**These evil people – they defile their own flesh...by being sexual immoral; they reject the authority and correction of scripture....and they speak evil against and reject the Glory of God – the Glory of His created angelic beings.**

## **Jude 1, Verse 9**

But even Michael, one of the mightiest of the angels, did not dare accuse the devil of blasphemy, but simply said, "The Lord rebuke you!" (This took place when Michael was arguing with the devil about Moses' body.)

**John 14:12** - 12 "I tell you the truth, anyone who believes in me will do the same works I have done, and even greater works, because I am going to be with the Father.

## **Daniel 10 - Daniel has been fasting and praying for 3 weeks - An angel appears to him with a message...verse 5-9**

5 I looked up and saw a man dressed in linen clothing, with a belt of pure gold around his waist. 6 His body looked like a precious gem. His face flashed like lightning, and his eyes flamed like torches. His arms and feet shone like polished bronze, and his voice roared like a vast multitude of people.

7 Only I, Daniel, saw this vision. The men with me saw nothing, but they were suddenly terrified and ran away to hide. 8 So I was left there all alone to see this amazing vision. My strength left me, my face grew deathly pale, and I felt very weak. 9 Then I heard the man speak, and when I heard the sound of his voice, I fainted and lay there with my face to the ground.

### **The angel that Daniel sees is so amazing that Daniel faints.....**

12 Then he said, "Don't be afraid, Daniel. Since the first day you began to pray for understanding and to humble yourself before your God, your request has been heard in heaven. I have come in answer to your prayer. 13 But for twenty-one days the spirit prince of the kingdom of Persia blocked my way. Then Michael, one of the archangels, came to help me, and I left him there with the spirit prince of the kingdom of Persia. 14 Now I am here to explain what will happen to your people in the future, for this vision concerns a time yet to come."

## **Ephesians 6, verse 12**

For we are not fighting against flesh-and-blood enemies, but against evil rulers and authorities of the unseen world, against mighty powers in this dark world, and against evil spirits in the heavenly places.

## Deuteronomy 34:5-6

5 So Moses, the servant of the Lord, died there in the land of Moab, just as the Lord had said. 6 The Lord buried him in a valley near Beth-peor in Moab, but to this day no one knows the exact place.

## Revelation 11:3-12

3 And I will give power to my **two witnesses**, and they will be clothed in burlap and will prophesy during those 1,260 days."

4 These two prophets are the two olive trees and the two lampstands that stand before the Lord of all the earth. 5 If anyone tries to harm them, fire flashes from their mouths and consumes their enemies. This is how anyone who tries to harm them must die. 6 **They have power to shut the sky so that no rain will fall for as long as they prophesy. And they have the power to turn the rivers and oceans into blood, and to strike the earth with every kind of plague as often as they wish.**

7 When they complete their testimony, the beast that comes up out of the bottomless pit will declare war against them, and he will conquer them and kill them. 8 And their bodies will lie in the main street of Jerusalem, the city that is figuratively called "Sodom" and "Egypt," the city where their Lord was crucified. 9 And for three and a half days, all peoples, tribes, languages, and nations will stare at their bodies. No one will be allowed to bury them. 10 All the people who belong to this world will gloat over them and give presents to each other to celebrate the death of the two prophets who had tormented them.

11 But after three and a half days, God breathed life into them, and they stood up! Terror struck all who were staring at them. 12 Then a loud voice from heaven called to the two prophets, "Come up here!" And they rose to heaven in a cloud as their enemies watched.

## **Matthew 17:1-8**

Six days later Jesus took Peter and the two brothers, James and John, and led them up a high mountain to be alone. 2 As the men watched, Jesus' appearance was transformed so that his face shone like the sun, and his clothes became as white as light. 3 Suddenly, Moses and Elijah appeared and began talking with Jesus.

4 Peter exclaimed, "Lord, it's wonderful for us to be here! If you want, I'll make three shelters as memorials—one for you, one for Moses, and one for Elijah."

5 But even as he spoke, a bright cloud overshadowed them, and a voice from the cloud said, "This is my dearly loved Son, who brings me great joy. Listen to him." 6 The disciples were terrified and fell face down on the ground.

7 Then Jesus came over and touched them. "Get up," he said. "Don't be afraid." 8 And when they looked up, Moses and Elijah were gone, and they saw only Jesus.
