

Who was the shortest reigning king of the bible? (1Kings 16:10)


**King Zimri**

Which 3 Kings reigned over the united kingdom?


King Saul, King David, King Solomon

- There Were 20 Kings of Judah 11 Started Evil & Ended Evil 5 Started Good & Ended Good 3 Started Good & Ended Evil 1 Started Evil & Ended Good
- The Kingdom of Judah's Reign Lasted 345 Years
- The Kingdom of Judah's Reign Lasted 136 Years Longer Than the Kingdom of Israel's Reign
- The Main Downfall of the Kingdom of Judah was Idol Worship and Worshipping False Gods

# What We Can Learn From Kingdoms Of The Bible

- There Were 19 Kings of Israel 18 Started Evil & Ended Evil 1 Started Good & Ended Evil
- The Kingdom of Israel's Reign Lasted 209 Years
- The Kingdom of Israel's Reign Ended 136 Years Before the Kingdom of Judah's Reign
- The Main Downfall of the Kingdom of Israel was Idol Worship and Worshipping False Gods



- Establishing a King was not God's plan
- God was grieved that people rejected Him as their king
- God was grieved that the people were serving other gods
- God knew the hardship that would come from establishing a king and He had Samuel warn the people
- I Sam 8:5~22

- God Changed His Heart ~ I Sam 10:9
- He Was Unsure/Insecure ~ I Sam 10:22 & I Sam 11:5
- He Was Equipped ~ I Sam 10:26 (Valiant Men)
- Prideful ~ 1 Sam 13:9~14 (Assuming the Priestly Role)
- Constantly at War ~ I Sam 14:52
- Unrepentant ~ 1 Sam 15:8~23
- Filled With Anger ~ I Sam 18:8~9
- Afraid of David ~ I Sam 18:10~12 & I Sam 16:14
- Conjuror ~ I Sam 28:3~25 (Conjured Samuel's Spirit)

#### What We Can Learn From King David

- Faithful ~ Tending his father's sheep I Sam 16:10~13 & I Sam 17:34~36
- Fearless ~ I Sam 17:31~58 (David kills Goliath)
- A Man of Honor ~ I Sam 24 (Spares Saul), I Sam 26 (Spares Saul Again), II Sam 16:1~16 (Kills The Man Who Took Saul's Life)
- Quick To Repent ~ II Sam 12:1~15
- A Man After God's Own Heart ~ I Sam 13:14/Acts 13:22
- A Man Who Knew How To Rely On God ~ All through the Psalms we see this also II Sam 22
- A Man Who Knew The Importance of Legacy ~ I Chron 22 (David sets aside what Solomon will need to build the temple)

#### What We Can Learn From Kings Of The Bible

- Whose kingdom are we establishing, God's or our own?
- What idols/false gods do we hold dear?
- What are we worshipping in the high places (the secret places)?
- Are we quick to repent or are we quick to make excuses when God speaks to us?
