- Given in 1995 as the mission statement for Carmel.
- (NKJV) He sent them to preach the Kingdom of God and heal the sick.
- (Passion) Then He commissioned them to preach God's Kingdom realm and to heal the sick to demonstrate that the kingdom had arrived.

WHY WE NEED VISION

Proverbs 29:18;



- (NASB) Where there is no vision, the people are unrestrained, But happy is he who keeps the law.
- (Passion) When there is no clear prophetic vision, people quickly wander astray. But when you follow the revelation of the word, heaven's bliss fills your soul.
- (TLB) Where there is ignorance of God, crime runs wild; but what a wonderful thing it is for a nation to know and keep his laws.

VISION REVEALS THE PLAN OF GOD



Habakkuk 2:2-4; (NASB)

- Then the Lord answered me and said, "Record the vision And inscribe it on tablets, That the one who reads it may run."

Vision helps us see where we are going.

- Just as natural vision is important to see where we are going, and what we need to build, so is spiritual vision necessary to guide us into the plan of the Lord.
- Vision requires a two fold revelation;
 (i) the ability to see with the eye of faith the image of what God is showing you,
 (ii) the ability of the Holy Spirit to interpret the vision in a manner that enables you to do it.

Ephesians 4:13; (NASB)



- The entire Bible is about God's vision. It was written to you, for you and about you. His purpose for creation was for all men, women and children of every age, race and culture in the entire world to KNOW Him.
- The PURPOSE of vision is that all of His creation to "attain the <u>unity of the faith</u>, and of the knowledge of the Son God, to a MATURE man, to the measure of the statute which belongs to the <u>fullness of Christ.</u>"



 skills needed to succeed in life.
- PETRA is a vital link between church and community that needs lots of support and participation. Training and support is on going. Every life matters for eternity.
