## Warm Up

- Have you ever had that "whoa" moment when you stepped out of a dark theater into daylight? How did it feel? What did you notice?
- Think about a time when you were "in the dark" about something important. How did you find clarity?
- What does "moving from darkness to light" mean in your own spiritual journey?

## Scripture Exploration

- Check out John 3:16-18. What hits you about why God sent His Son?
- How does John 3:19-21 talk about people's reactions to light and darkness?
- In Ezekiel 36:26, God promises a new heart. How does this connect to what you read in John 3?

## Personal Reflection

- What's your take on "light has come into the world" from John 3:19-21?
- The sermon mentioned eternal life starting now. How does that change how you see your daily life?
- How does seeing Jesus as both Savior and Lord challenge or support your current faith?

## Personal Application

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- Are there parts of your life where you feel you're still "in the dark"? What can you do to bring Jesus' light there?
- How can you team up with someone to keep each other accountable in your walk with Jesus?
- What distractions might be keeping you from fully surrendering to Jesus? What can you do to cut down on these distractions?
- How can you share John 3:16-18 with someone this week? What difference do you hope it makes?
