

## Study Guide: John 2:1-12

This guide is designed to help you engage deeply with the themes discussed in the sermon, reflect on the biblical text, and apply the message to your life. Use the questions to guide your study this week, and consider how the insights gained can influence your walk with Christ and your interactions with others.

### Reading

- John 2:1-12

### Warm Up

- Think about a time when you had to prepare for a special occasion. What rituals or preparations did you go through to ensure everything was perfect?
- How do you currently understand the concept of spiritual cleanliness? What practices or beliefs shape your understanding?

### Scripture Exploration

- Read John 2:1-12. What details stand out to you about the setting and the actions of Jesus?
- How does the cultural context of purification rituals in the Jewish tradition enhance your understanding of this miracle?
- What is the significance of Jesus using the purification jars to perform his first miracle?

### Personal Reflection

- What does the transformation of water into wine symbolize in the context of the new covenant through Jesus?
- How does Isaiah 53:10 and Matthew 27:46 deepen your understanding of the sacrifice Jesus made?
- Reflect on Romans 4:7-8. What does it mean for our sins to be covered, and how does this relate to the sermon's message?

### Personal Application

- How can you incorporate the understanding that Jesus' sacrifice is sufficient for your spiritual cleanliness into your daily life?
- Consider your personal rituals or routines. How might they change if you focus more on the spiritual significance rather than the habit itself?
- What steps can you take to ensure your participation in church activities is meaningful and not just ritualistic?
- How can you share the message of Jesus' transformative power with others in your community this week?
