Reading

- John 1:6-16

- Romans 8:17

Warm Up

- What does being part of a family mean to you, and how have you experienced this in your own life?
- Reflect on a time you felt welcomed into a community or group. What made that experience meaningful?
- How do you currently understand your role in God's family?

Scripture Exploration

- Read John 1:6-16. What do these verses tell us about the identity and mission of Jesus?
- How does the concept of light and darkness play out in these verses, and why is it significant?
- What role does John the Baptist play in this passage, and how does he point others to Jesus?

Personal Reflection

- How does understanding Jesus as the light influence your view of the world and your place in it?
- Explore Hebrews 2:11. What does it mean to be called a brother or sister by Jesus?
- Romans 8:17 speaks of being heirs with Christ. How does this affect your understanding of your spiritual inheritance?

Personal Application

- Consider your current relationship with Jesus. How can you deepen your understanding of being part of God's family?
