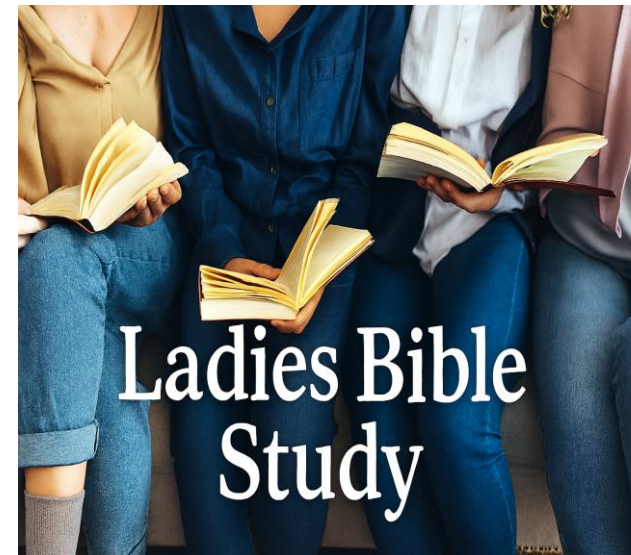
## Memorial Service for Bonnie Shapbell
