Matthew 16:18-19 ... I tell you that you are Peter, and on this rock (truth, foundation), I will build (assemble) my church (called out ones), and the gates of Hades will not overcome (constrain, limit) it. I will give you the keys of the kingdom of heaven; whatever you bind (kabash, control) on earth will be bound in heaven, and whatever you (permit, govern) on earth will be loosed in heaven."

Praying in the Wild

<u>Jurisdictional</u> Authority: the authority I have over my spheres of responsibility. This is "my" authority exercised in areas of my jurisdiction.

<u>Ambassadorial</u> Authority: the authority that accompanies one who speaks on behalf of another.

Advance the Kingdom Prayers

Jurisdictional Prayer (natural and spiritual FAM/LY)

"No weapon formed against me shall prosper. No evil shall befall me nor any plague come near my dwelling. Every tongue that accuses me in judgment, I shall condemn. This is my inheritance, and my vindication comes from You, Lord. Therefore, I cancel every assignment of the enemy and turn away and negate any curse spoken against me. In its place, I speak blessing over our lives and our legacy."

(See Psalm 91:10, Isaiah 54:17, Luke 11:21-22, Matthew 16:19, Ephesians 6:12)

Ambassadorial Prayer (blessing)

Make the following declarations to the powers and principalities as you **Speak** in behalf of Jesus Christ.

- 1. Declare that this land (business, school, etc.) belongs to God.
 - Joshua 1:3
- 2. Declare that these people belong to God.
 - Psalm 24:1
- 3. Declare that the kingdom will be established in that land in power.

- Matthew 11:12
- 4. Declare that the Gospel will be openly preached and the church firmly established.
 - Romans 1:16
- 5. Demand that scales be removed from people's eyes that they might see.
 - 2 Corinthians 4:3-6 (NIV)
