 - The Resurrection (Matthew 28:2)
 - The Mission is Underway (Acts 2: 1-4)

4. Mission _____ Underway

"... there before me was a great multitude that no one could count, from every nation, tribe, people, and language, standing before the throne and before the Lamb. (Revelation 7:9)

- There are still neighbors.
- Still prodigals.
- Still tribes.
- Still languages.
- Still unengaged peoples.
- Still unreached peoples.
