1. The Mission: GO and MAKE disciples of all Nations... (Matthew 28:19a)

1. All Nations (*panta ta ethne*) = all people or ethnic groups.
2. Disciples = *Blue Collar* Community
3. Obedience = GO and Make
4. Disciples = reproduce obedient Christ followers

Mission ≠ Church Program

Gathering Worshipers of Christ from all peoples.

This Gospel ... all people groups ... then the end will come. (Matthew 24:14)

1. **Certainty** – “...will be proclaimed ...”
2. **Scope** – “... throughout the whole world ... to all *ethne*.”
3. **Sequence** – “... then the end will come.”
