



## Why Do Bad Things Happen to Good People pt 2 Romans 8:19-28

### 1. The Surprising **MERCY** of God

- Psalm 103:8–14                      – Luke 15                      – Matthew 5:45
- A better question might be: “*Why do good things happen to bad people?*” The answer: because God is **MERCIFUL** and compassionate.
- God gives sun and rain to the just and unjust alike—not because we deserve it, but because He is **GOOD**.

### 2. \_\_\_\_\_: The Righteous Suffered for the Unrighteous

- Romans 5:8      – Isaiah 53:3–6      – 1 Peter 3:18                      – Hebrews 4:15
- Jesus willingly endured \_\_\_\_\_ and \_\_\_\_\_ so that sinners could be reconciled to God.
- At the cross, we see both divine \_\_\_\_\_ and divine \_\_\_\_\_ fully displayed.
- Our suffering has meaning because we follow a Savior who suffered to bring us hope.

### 3. God is Working \_\_\_\_\_ Things for Good

- Romans 8:28                      – 2 Corinthians 4:17                      – Revelation 21:4
- God never \_\_\_\_\_ our suffering or hardships.
- Suffering \_\_\_\_\_ character, deepens faith, and reveals God’s greater purposes.

### 4. The Promise of Future \_\_\_\_\_

- 2 Corinthians 4:17                      – Colossians 2:13-15
- **SUFFERING** is temporary; glory is eternal.
- Our present suffering will give way to resurrection joy.
- The **DRAMA** of the Ages will reveal the full plan of God.
