## A LOVE <u>NEGLECTED</u> IS A LOVE LOST

• Matthew 26:69-75 <sup>69</sup> Now Peter was sitting outside in the courtyard. And a servant girl came up to him and said, "You also were with Jesus the Galilean." <sup>70</sup> But he denied it before them all, saying, "I do not know what you mean." <sup>71</sup> And when he went out to the entrance, another servant girl saw him, and she said to the bystanders, "This man was with Jesus of Nazareth." <sup>72</sup> And again he denied it with an oath: "I do not know the man." <sup>73</sup> After a little while the bystanders came up and said to Peter, "Certainly you too are one of them, for your accent betrays you." <sup>74</sup> Then he began to invoke a curse on himself and to swear, "I do not know the man." And immediately the rooster crowed. <sup>75</sup> And Peter remembered the saying of Jesus, "Before the rooster crows, you will deny me three times." And he went out and wept bitterly.

## JESUS OFFERS US A <u>SECOND</u> CHANCE

- John 21:15-17 When they had finished breakfast, Jesus said to Simon Peter, "Simon, son of John, do you Love¹ me more than these?" He said to him, "Yes, Lord; you know that I love² you." He said to him, "Feed my lambs." ¹⁶ He said to him a second time, "Simon, son of John, do you LOVE¹ me?" He said to him, "Yes, Lord; you know that I love² you." He said to him, "Tend my sheep." ¹¹ He said to him the third time, "Simon, son of John, do you love² me?" Peter was grieved because he said to him the third time, "Do you love me?" and he said to him, "Lord, you know everything; you know that I love you." Jesus said to him, "Feed my sheep.
  - Agape = the <u>HIGHEST</u> form of love. (Sacrificial love demonstrated on the Cross)
  - 2. **Phileo = BROTHERLY** love. (**Imperfect** but forgiving love existing between close friends.)
  - **SINCERE** love is a love that has the ability to grow over time.
  - There is no amount of BROKENNESS in our lives that can keep us from the love of God.

- 1. Create a special time and place to spend time with God.
  - Choose a LOCATION that is free from distractions.
  - Choose a time and make an **APPOINTMENT** with God.

#### 2. RANDOM ACT OF KINDNESS.

- Express your love for God by <u>BLESSING</u> someone else. (Buy A stranger's lunch in the drive thru).
