- 1. Talk about a time when you were attempting to control your own life. What difficulties did you encounter as you fought for control? Share what ultimately inspired you to hand over the reins to God.
- 2. Discuss the fact that God's view of you is different from your view of yourself. While you see your limitations, God sees your potential. How does this make you feel? Thinking about your past or self-perception, share what you need to release to receive the new identity God has for you.
- 3. Talk about where you currently are on a scale of 1 (white-knuckled control) to 10 (total surrender). What practical steps can you take this week to increase the scale and release more of your life to God?
