Romans 1:19-20 (ESV) For what can be known about God is plain to them, because God has show it to them. For his invisible attributes, namely, his eternal power and divine nature, have been clearly perceived, ever since the creation of the world, in the things that have been made.

Four Laws of Hermeneutics (interpreting and applying scripture)
1. Law of First
When a word or concept is first introduced in the Bible, its meaning and use often shed importal light on God's original intent and inform our understanding and biblical theology (understanding God).
2. Law of
Every text has a specific context that determines its meaning and application. This context includes the people, culture, time, place, and situation. (I.e. Jeremiah 29:11)
 <u>Principles</u> are timeless; <u>Promises</u> are conditional.
3. Law of
Christian doctrine (teaching) must be consistent with the whole counsel of God's Word. Our culture and context are subject to change. God is not. Man is famous for attempting to "make Gin his own image."
4. Law of
Christian doctrine (teaching) must be in agreement (harmony) with God's character and Nature portrayed in the CONTEXT of the Holy Scriptures.
"Love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your mind." I is the first and greatest commandment. And the second is like it: 'Love your neighbor as yourself.' the Law and the Prophets hang on these two commandments." Exodus 34:5-7 NIV Then the Lord came down in the cloud and stood there with (Moses) a proclaimed his name, the Lord. And he passed in front of Moses, proclaiming, "The Lord, the Lot the compassionate and gracious God, slow to anger, abounding in love and faithfulne maintaining love to thousands, and forgiving wickedness, rebellion and sin. Yet he does leave the guilty unpunished; he punishes the children and their children for the sin of parents to the third and fourth generation."
