2. Seekers from Afar

The Magi traveled a great distance from Persia to seek Jesus. What does their journey reveal about the nature of true spiritual hunger—and what might that say about how we approach seeking Christ today?

3. The Meaning of the Gifts

Gold, frankincense, and myrrh each point to who Jesus is—King, God, and Sacrifice. Which of these aspects of Jesus do you find easiest to embrace, and which challenges you the most right now?

4. The Way of the Wise

Looking at the pattern of the wise men—seeking, worshiping, obeying, and giving—where do you sense God inviting you to grow or realign your life more closely with Christ?

5. From Wisdom to Action

What might it look like practically for you to bring Jesus your “gold,” “frankincense,” or “myrrh” in this season? Is there a plan to surrender, worship to renew, or something you need to lay down?

6. Seeking Together

How could participating in a focused season of prayer (like Seek Week) help move your faith from knowledge to action? What would you hope God might reveal or reshape in you during that time?
