1 Peter 1:1-2

To God's **elect**, exiles scattered throughout the provinces of Pontus, Galatia, Cappadocia, Asia, and Bithynia, who have been **chosen** according to **the foreknowledge** of God the Father, through the **sanctifying work of the Spirit**, to be obedient to Jesus Christ and **sprinkled with his blood**: Grace and peace be yours in abundance.

Companion Verse

Ephesians 1: 4-8

For He <u>chose</u> us in Him (Jesus) <u>before</u> (*Genesis 1*) the creation of the world <u>to be</u> holy and blameless in his sight. In love He <u>predestined</u> us for <u>adoption</u> to sonship through Jesus Christ, in accordance (*harmony*) with His pleasure and will to the praise of His glorious grace, which He has <u>freely given</u> us in the One He loves (Jesus). In Him (Jesus) we have <u>redemption</u> (*restoration*) through His blood, the forgiveness of sins, in accordance with the riches of God's grace that He lavished (*heaped, showered, smothered*) on us.
