



# **Lessons from Palm Sunday**

March 28, 2021

#### Matthew 21:1-7

As they approached Jerusalem and came to Bethphage (House of Green Figs) on the Mount of Olives, Jesus sent two disciples, <sup>2</sup> saying to them, "Go to the village ahead of you, and at once you will find a donkey tied there, with her colt by her. Untie them and bring them to me. <sup>3</sup> If anyone says anything to you, say that the Lord needs them, and he will send them right away." <sup>4</sup> This took place to fulfill what was spoken through the prophet: <sup>5</sup> "Say to Daughter Zion, 'See, your king comes to you, gentle and riding on a donkey, and on a colt, the foal of a donkey." <sup>6</sup> The disciples went and did as Jesus had instructed them. <sup>7</sup> They brought the donkey and the colt and placed their cloaks on them for Jesus to sit on.

#### **Matthew 21:8-9**

A very large crowd spread their cloaks on the road, while others cut branches from the trees and spread them on the road. <sup>9</sup> The crowds that went ahead of him and those that followed shouted,

"Hosanna (save us) to the Son of David!"

"Blessed is he who comes in the name of the Lord!"

"Hosanna in the highest heaven!"

### 2. You Can Trust God's Character

- a. Jesus' actions confirmed Him as Messiah (the anointed one that rescues / delivers) Matthew 11:2-6, John 9:32
- b. He is immutable (unchanging) James 1:17, Hebrews 13:8

## 3. You Cannot Mold (manipulate) God in Your Own (desired) Image

- a. Scholars agree Hosanna in this context of takes on the tone of a command to bring or cause salvation.
- b. Many tried to manipulate or control Christ. Matthew 20:20-21, John 6:16
- c. Some prefer a *Plastic* Jesus. Deuteronomy 5:7, Matthew 16: 13-15

Question: Can you think of a time when you tried to *fit* Christ to your mold?

#### Matthew 21:10-11

When Jesus entered Jerusalem, the whole city was stirred and asked, "Who is this?" The crowds answered, "This is Jesus, the *prophet* from Nazareth in Galilee."

#### 4. You Can Trust God's Process

- a. Delay is not denial.
- b. Misconception should not lead to rejection.
- c. Crisis does not mean desertion.
  - Betraval
  - Injustice
  - Unrelenting Pain of the cross
  - Sealed Tomb
- d. God's processes bring the hidden to light. Jerimiah 17:10, Romans 8:27
- e. Failing to understand God's processes can lead to isolation and sullenness. Jonah 4:5, John 20:25, John 2:27

## 5. You Can Trust Jesus, the King that Saves

- a. Jesus' came to RESCUE. Luke 19:10
- b. God accepted Jesus' death as full payment for your sin. Romans 3:25
- c. He will FORIGIVE, RESCUE, SAVE, DELIVER all who call on HIS name. Acts 2:21, Romans 10:13,1 Corinthians 1:2

Question: Have you **CALLED** on the name of the Lord to forgive and deliver you?

### My Thoughts:

### Hebrews 7:25

Therefore he is able, once and forever, to save those who come to God through him. He lives forever to intercede (*talk*) with God on their behalf.(!)
