James 1:1

James, a servant of God and of the Lord Jesus Christ, to the twelve tribes scattered among the nations: Greetings.

Written around 59 A.D. by James (½ brother of Jesus) the Bishop of the Jerusalem Church. Addressed to the persecuted Christians refugees	Works – Ch 2
scattered around Asia Minor.	Wait – Ch 5

James 1:2-3 Consider it pure joy, my brothers, whenever you face trials of many kinds ... because you know that the testing of your faith produces <u>perseverance</u>. Let perseverance finish its work so that you may be **mature and complete, not lacking anything.**

- 1. Trials are INEVITABLE, NUMEROUS and DIVERSE
- 2. RECOGNIZE what's really going on.

- 3. **COOPERATE** with God's growth process.

- 5. Keep a good attitude.

(Stay confident, remain steadfast in your prayers, avoid negative internal and external dialogs)

- 6. Stay <u>HUMBLE</u>.
