Five Biblical Purposes For Your Life¹**1. Worship: You Were _____ for God's Pleasure.**

- Purpose starts before activity – with ADORATION. (Genesis 2:7)
- Worship is not an event; it's a life centered on God. (Ephesians 2:10a)
- *Man's chief end is to glorify God and to enjoy him forever.* (Westminster Short Catechism)

Worship is Best Demonstrated Through Surrender and Trust.

2. Fellowship: You Were _____ for God's Family.

- Purpose is shaped in Christ and among His people. (Acts 2:41-42, 46)
- You cannot become like Christ in isolation. (James 3:18 MSG)
- Discipleship is not information—it is transformation in community. (Matthew 22:37-40)

God Forms Us Privately – But Matures Us Relationally.

3. Discipleship: You Were _____ to Become Like Christ.

- Choose to let go of our old ways of acting. (Ephesians 4:22 MSG)
- Change the way we think. (Ephesians 4:23 CEV)
- Put on the character of Christ by developing godly habits. (Ephesians 4:24 NIV)

The Process of Becoming Like Christ — Always Begins With a Decision.

4. Ministry: You Were _____ for Serving God.

- You were placed on this earth for a SPECIAL ASSIGNMENT. (Jeremiah 1:5)
- You're not saved by service, but you are saved for service. (2 Timothy 1:9)
- You are commanded to Serve and to Give. (Matthew 20:28)

Through Ministry, We Discover the Meaning of Our Lives.

5. Evangelism: You Were _____ for Mission.

- Your mission is a continuation of Jesus' mission on earth. ((Matthew 28:19)
- You are the only Christ Follower some people will ever know. (2 Corinthians 5:20 MSG)
- Your mission has eternal significance. (Romans 10:14-15)

"You don't have to find your mission—you already have one."
