Big Idea: Holy Spirit is your onboard; Eternal Guidance System.

1. Come Holy Spirit to _____ me.

- **John 14:26 - 27** But the Counselor, the Holy Spirit, whom the Father will send in my name, will teach you all things and will remind you of everything I have said to you. Peace, I leave with you; my peace I give you. I do not give to you as the world gives. Do not let your hearts be troubled and do not be afraid.

2. Come Holy Spirit and _____ Truth to me.

- **Hebrews 4:12-13** NLT For the word of God is alive and powerful. It is sharper than the sharpest two-edged sword, cutting between soul and spirit, between joint and marrow. It exposes our innermost thoughts and desires. Nothing in all creation is hidden from God. Everything is naked and exposed before his eyes, and he is the one to whom we are accountable.
- **John 15:26** “When the Counselor comes, whom I will send to you from the Father, the Spirit of truth who goes out from the Father, he will testify about me.”

3. Come Holy Spirit and _____ me.

- **Acts 1:8** NIV “But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes on you; and you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the ends of the earth.”
- **John 16:8** “When he comes, he will convict the world of guilt in regard to sin and righteousness and judgment.”

4. Come Holy Spirit and _____ me.

- Psalm 139:23-24 NLT Search me, O God, and know my heart; test me and know my anxious thoughts. Point out anything in me that offends you and lead me along the path of everlasting life.
- John 16:13 NIV “But when he, the Spirit of truth, comes, he will guide you into all truth. He will not speak on his own; he will speak only what he hears, and he will tell you what is yet to come.”

5. Come Holy Spirit and _____ me.

- Isaiah 30:21 NIV Whether you turn to the right or to the left, your ears will hear a voice behind you, saying, “This is the way; walk in it.”

1. Discuss a time when you experienced the COMFORT of Holy Spirit.

Can you share a time when God's correction led you to repentance and transformation? Can you share a time when you suffered for not heeding His correction?
