1.	 Christ's Call is "Come, follow me," Jesus said, "and I will send you out to fish for people." Matthew 4:19
2.	 Christ's Call is "If anyone comes to me and does not hate father and mother, wife and children, brothers and sisters—yes, even their own life—such a person cannot be my disciple. Luke 14:26
3.	Christ's Call is • " I will send you out to fish for people." Matthew 4:19
