1. Fun Facts

- First Book Printed (1455 A.D.)66 "books" = Library
- Best Seller: 273,972 a day 11,415 an hour 190 a minute 3 a second

2. God's Owner's Manual (Handbook for Life)

- Raising kids Improving your marriage
- Handling your money Breaking bad habits Findi
- Receiving / granting forgiveness

- Managing your emotions
- Finding fulfillment in life
- Receiving eternal life

3. Multiple Writers - One Author

- Kings Servants Philosophers Fishermen
- Poets Doctors Military Leaders 1st Century IRS agent

4. Singular Message

- God worked throughout history to restore His relationship with human race.
- One hero the Messiah One villain Satan
- One problem Sin One purpose Salvation

5. Obvious Conclusion

- There is ONE Master Architect, Designer reflected in the Bible, Creation and Mankind.

6. Eyewitness Reports

- The New Testament writers knew Jesus personally - 30-45 post Resurrection

7. Literary (integrity) Evidence

- 24,000 copies of the N.T. (earliest 100 A.D.) < 1 variation in 1000 words
- 14,000 copies or fragments of the O.T. < 1 variation in 1580 words
- Dead Sea Scrolls (250-150 B.C.) compared to text 1000 years older = 95% identical.
- Writings of the Church Father's quote 36,000 verses of the N.T. (-11 verses)

8. Historical Evidence

- The Iliad (Homer): 643 existing copies, earliest 500 years after original
- Republic (Plato): 7 existing copies, earliest 900 years after original
- 25,000+ archeological discoveries that substantiate the validity of scripture.
- Luke/Acts names thirty-two countries, fifty-four cities and nine islands without an error.

9. Prophetic Accuracy

- The Bible contains 1,817 individual predictions, concerning 737 separate subjects, found in 8,352 verses, that's 27% of the 31,124 verses found in the Bible!
- The OT contains 48 specific prophecies w/ some 300 ramifications referring to the Messiah. Every prophecy was published at least 500 years before Christ was born.
