The Relationship Question

GOOD questions result in **BETTER** decisions resulting in **FEWER** regrets.

- 1. (Super-Power) Ask / Answer Honestly / Act with Integrity
- 2. Honesty Question: Am I being honest with myself, REALLY?
- 3. Legacy Question: What STORY do I want to tell?
- 4. Conscience Question: Is there a <u>TENSION</u> that deserves my <u>ATTENTION</u>?
- 5. Maturity Question: What is the WISE thing to do?
