1. Jonah was living a contradiction. He knew God intimately, desired his forgiveness but withheld forgiveness from the Ninevites. Who is God asking you to forgive?
2. As we see in the life of Jonah, God is the great provider. He provided a storm, fish, vine, worm, and the wind. What in your life has been a direct provision from God? What was the purpose of his provision?
3. Of the estimated **7.75 billion** people alive in the world today, **3.23 billion** of them like the **Ninevites** live with little or no access to the Gospel of Jesus Christ. What do you know about these unreached, unengaged people groups (UUPGs)?
4. According to [Joshua Project](#), there are 7,400+ UUPGs. That is over 41% of the world's population! The vast majority (85%) of these least reached groups exist in the 10/40 window and less than 10% of missionary work is done among these people. Want to know more? Join a Count for Zero Small Group
