

Grace That Adorns, Trains, and Sends

Titus 2:9–15

Main Idea:

Grace saves us, trains us, and sends us to live in a way that makes the gospel look beautiful

1) Adorn the Doctrine in our Work (2:9–10)

- Live with integrity and respect: well pleasing, not argumentative
- Be trustworthy: not pilfering, showing all good faith
- **Purpose:** “adorn the doctrine of God our Savior”
- Workplace takeaway: work to honor Christ first, not man

2) Grace Saves and Trains (2:11–12)

- Grace has appeared bringing salvation
- Grace trains us to renounce ungodliness and worldly passions
- Grace trains us to live self controlled, upright, godly lives now
- Key takeaway: grace does not only forgive, grace forms

3) Hope Fuels Holiness (2:13–15)

- Waiting for our blessed hope: Christ’s appearing
- Christ gave Himself to redeem and purify a people for His possession
- Zealous for good works
- Declare, exhort, rebuke with authority!
