- Seek first His Kingdom: there is a call to examine our lives and to seek to bring all areas of our lives into alignment with God's will and ways.

- 5. In regard to the potential purchase of Unit 5, spend some time as group praying into this decision. As you pray, share with the group if you believe you have heard anything from God.











The average weekly attendance on a Sunday in 2021 is currently 296, with a total of 407 including Redkids and Youth.




Baptisms






