




January - December 2018 (audited figures)








January - October 2019 (unaudited figures)



Represents 7.06 FTE Staff at 31 October 2019





- All approvals will be gained before using unit 2.










Baptisms

In 2018 we saw 29 people baptised in the life of The Red Door Community.


2019 baptisms to date are 12.
