Pray First, Day 2 - That The Lost Might Be Saved

1 Timothy 2:1-4 NKJV

1 Therefore I exhort first of all that supplications, prayers, intercessions, and giving of thanks be made for all men, 2 for kings and all who are in authority, that we may lead a quiet and peaceable life in all godliness and reverence. 3 For this is good and acceptable in the sight of God our Savior, 4 who desires all men to be saved and to come to the knowledge of the truth.

One of the most important gifts that God has given His people is the gift of prayer. He invites us to use that gift for the good of others and to bring about His will into their lives.

God desires for our family, friends, and neighbors to be saved. We are invited to pray for them to come to the knowledge of the truth so that they can experience the same relationship and freedom we have in Christ.

Prayer example:

"Heavenly Father, I give you thanks for Your great love for humanity. I pray for my loved ones, co-workers, friends, and neighbors that do not yet know You. I ask that You will begin to move in their lives in a powerful way this year so that they might be saved. Let Your truth come to them and if You choose to use me to share it, please give me the right words to say that they may hear. I declare that today is the day of salvation in Jesus' name amen!"
