In the Book of Ecclesiastes, King Solomon shared his own experience of getting lost on some dead end streets. In his search for meaning in life apart from God ("under the sun"), he tested several roads that led only to dejection and despair.

In our text, King Solomon discovered that every road he took in his search for meaning in life under the sun was a dead end street.
