In the United States, a person must clock at least 1500 hours of real-world experience in piloting an airplane to be considered as a captain of a commercial airliner. Classroom training alone is not enough to entrust a pilot with an airliner carrying around 200 passengers.

The stakes are even greater for the church. We have been entrusted with carrying the good news about Jesus to a lost and dying world. As followers of Christ, it is essential for us to clock real-world experience in living sent for the gospel of Christ.

In our text, Jesus sent out His twelve disciples to do the work of ministry and evangelism that they had observed Him doing.
