Have you ever had a secret that was too good to keep to yourself? Perhaps there has been a time that you knew something so wonderful that you just couldn't hold it in. You had to share it with someone.

This is how all believers should feel about the gospel of Jesus Christ. The word "gospel" comes from the Greek word *euaggelion*, which means "good news." Each of us are called by God and empowered by His Spirit to share the good news about Jesus with others (Acts 1:8).

In our text, the Holy Spirit led a believer named Philip to a road in the desert to share the gospel of Jesus with an official from Ethiopia.
