King Hezekiah of Judah was that kind of leader. When he came to the throne, Judah was a nation overrun with compromise, corruption, and rampant idolatry. The Temple doors were closed and the "high places" of false worship stood on every hill.

In our text, King Hezekiah did what was right in the eyes of the Lord and tore down the high places of false worship in Judah.
