Oliver Wendell Holmes was asked, "What is the most important factor in a man's success?" He replied, "He must choose the right parents." Sadly, children don't get to choose their parents. Yet, for good or bad, a child's parents will play a vital role in what he or she will become.

We see this truth in the Bible story of Eli who was both a priest and judge in Israel (1 Sam. 1:9b; 4:18b). Though Eli was a respected leader, he was a real loser as a parent. The sins of his two sons, Hophni and Phinehas, were very great in the sight of the Lord (1 Sam. 3:17a).

In our text, Eli was known as leader in Israel, but he forgot that leadership begins at home.
