INTRODUCTION

God tells us throughout Scripture to see people and serve people who are vulnerable or forgotten. The Bible makes it so clear that Jesus cares about the one. He sees the one that others may not see. He loves the one that others may not love. He believes in the one that others may not believe in. He chases the one that others gave up on. Jesus cares about THE one...and He encourages us to do the same. To do that, we must follow five steps that are clearly outlined in Scripture.

KEY POINTS

1. Life Selflessly

Do nothing out of selfish ambition or conceit, but in humility consider others as more important than yourselves. Everyone should look not to his own interests, but rather to the interests of others. – Philippians 2:3-4

2. Serve Faithfully

Just as each one has received a gift, use it to serve others, as good stewards of the varied grace of God. If anyone speaks, let it be as one who speaks God's words; if anyone serves, let it be from the strength God provides, so that God may be glorified through Jesus Christ in everything. -1 Peter 4:10-11

3. Provide Tangibly

Don't neglect to do what is good and to share, for God is pleased with such sacrifices. – Hebrews 13:16

4. Give Generously

The point is this: The person who sows sparingly will also reap sparingly, and the person who sows generously will also reap generously. Each person should do as he has decided in his heart —not reluctantly or out of compulsion, since God loves a cheerful giver. And God is able to make every grace overflow to you, so that in every way, always having everything you need, you may excel in every good work. – 2 Corinthians 9:6-8

5. Evangelize Consistently

Go into all the world and preach the gospel to all creation." – Mark 16:15 $\,$
