INTRODUCTION

If I were to give the church at Thyatira a name, it would be The Tolerant Church. In today's key passage, Jesus criticizes this congregation and calls them out for tolerating things they should have been rejecting. There's a lot we can learn from this church so that we can keep ourselves from tolerating what we should be rejecting in our own lives.

KEY POINTS

1. Truths About Toleration

- If the church becomes tolerant of the culture, the church will cease to exist.
- Spiritual compromise isn't choosing other gods to worship instead of Jesus. Spiritual compromise is elevating other gods & worshipping them next to Jesus.
- The quickest way to kill a church is to lower God's standards and compromise God's Word.
- If we tolerate sin, there will be consequences.
- If we tolerate sin, consequences will impact (not only you... it'll impact) those around us.
