KEY POINTS	
1. Revelation Has a Central Figure The book of Revelation is not merely a collection of symbols, prophecies, or apocalyptic imagery—it is a revelation of Jesus Christ. Its purpose is to unveil His majesty and display His deity to the world. Jesus is both the revealer and the revealed, making Him the focus of this book.	
2. Revelation Has a Clear Purpose The purpose of Revelation is to show God's servants "what must soon take place" (Rev. 1:1). This book equips believers to live ready for the last days by revealing future events and reminding us of our identity as surrendered servants of Christ.	
3. Revelation Has a Certain Promise Revelation 1:3 assures us of a unique blessing for those who read, hear, and obey its words. This promise emphasizes the importance of engaging with Revelation faithfully and highlights the urgency of its message because "the time is near."

When God instructed John to write the Book of Revelation, He told him to write what he had seen, what currently is, and what is to come in the future. Understanding each of these components is the key to understanding Revelation and the message God has for us in this important book.	
KEY POINTS	
1. The Past In Revelation 1:9–20, John describes his vision of Christ in His majesty and glory, emphasizing His authority and divine attributes. Jesus appears in His glorified body, reminding us of His role as judge, redeemer, and ruler. This vision serves as a reminder of Christ's ultimate victory and authority.	
2. The Present Revelation 2–3 contains letters to seven churches in Asia Minor, addressing both their strengths and weaknesses. These letters emphasize Christ's presence among His churches and His attentiveness to their faithfulness. The messages remain relevant today, challenging churches to evaluate their unity, love, and commitment to God's mission.	
3. The Future Revelation 4–22 unveils the events that will take place after the church age, including the tribulation, Christ's return, and the ultimate defeat of Satan. This section emphasizes living in readiness and victory, knowing that Christ will triumph and establish His eternal kingdom.

The Seals Will Be Broken

Revealed | Week 3 | Revelation 6-7

INTRODUCTION	NOTES
According to Revelation 6 and 7, after the Church is raptured, the Tribulation will begin. In this message, Pastor Jordan Easley helps us understand exactly what will happen during the horrific period of the Tribulation, and he explains the six seals that will be broken during this time.	
KEY POINTS	
1. The First Seal Is Broken: The Antichrist Comes To Rule When the first seal is broken, the Antichrist comes riding on a white horse, symbolizing deception and false peace. He carries a bow without arrows, offering fake solutions to a world in chaos. Empowered by satanic forces, he consolidates power through deceit, but his reign is temporary and destructive.	
2. The Second Seal Is Broken: A Time Of War Begins On Earth The breaking of the second seal unleashes conflict and war. The fiery red horse represents the removal of peace, leading to widespread violence and slaughter. Nations and individuals turn against one another, resulting in unimaginable bloodshed.	
3. The Third Seal Is Broken: Famine & Misfortune The third seal reveals economic collapse. The black horse rider carries scales, symbolizing control over scarce resources. Inflation and poverty grip the world as people labor for sustenance, while the wealthy continue to prosper, highlighting extreme inequality.	
4. The Fourth Seal Is Broken: Plagues, Disease, & Death The pale green horse introduces death on a massive scale. One-fourth of the world's population is killed through war, famine, plagues, and wild beasts. The devastation is a stark reminder of the consequences of sin and rebellion.	
5. The Fifth Seal Is Broken: Tribulation Saints Are Saved The fifth seal shifts focus to the martyrs in heaven who have been slain for their faith during the Tribulation. They cry out for justice, and God reassures them that more will join them before His judgment is complete. Their perseverance emphasizes God's mercy even in judgment.	
6. The Sixth Seal Is Broken: Catastrophic Events In Nature The breaking of the sixth seal results in catastrophic natural events: earthquakes, a blackened sun, a blood-red moon, and falling stars. The heavens and earth are shaken, causing the world's leaders and people to hide in fear, yet they refuse to repent. This seal underscores the inevitability of God's wrath.

The Trumpets Will Be Blown

Revealed | Week 4 | Revelation 8-9

INTRODUCTION	NOTES
The book of Revelation reveals God's divine plan layer by layer. As the seventh seal is broken, silence in heaven signals the trumpet judgments—an escalation of God's righteous response to sin and a call to repentance. Through these trumpets, we see not just judgment but also God's deep desire for humanity to turn back to Him.	
KEY POINTS	
1. First Trumpet Sounds—Impacts Food Source The first trumpet unleashes hail and fire mixed with blood, burning a third of the earth, trees, and green grass. This catastrophic event disrupts the global food supply, destroying fruit trees, grain, and vegetation essential for life.	
2. Second Trumpet Sounds—Impacts Marine Life A fiery mountain crashes into the sea, turning a third of the waters into blood. Marine life dies, and a third of the ships are destroyed. This devastates the marine industry and disrupts ecosystems globally.	
3. Third Trumpet Sounds—Impacts Drinking Water A blazing star named Wormwood poisons a third of the freshwater sources. The bitter water becomes undrinkable, leading to widespread death and chaos as people face the critical loss of clean water.	
4. Fourth Trumpet Sounds—Impacts Sunlight The fourth trumpet darkens a third of the sun, moon, and stars, reducing daylight and plunging the world into partial darkness. This judgment disrupts the planet's ecological balance, affecting energy and life.	
5. Fifth Trumpet Sounds—Demonic Infestation on the Earth Satan releases demons from the abyss, tormenting humanity for five months. These demonic forces, described as locusts with scorpion-like stings, afflict those without God's seal, symbolizing spiritual and physical agony.	
6. Sixth Trumpet Sounds—A Murderous Army is Mobilized A demonic army of 200 million is released, killing a third of humanity. This unprecedented war pits the spiritual forces of hell against humanity, resulting in death and destruction on a massive scale.

Power of Pause

NOTES **INTRODUCTION** Life often brings us to forks in the road—critical moments requiring us to choose our path. In Revelation 10, God provides humanity with one final pause, a significant window of time to choose repentance before the coming judgment intensifies. This chapter reveals God's mercy, offering a last opportunity for people to turn to Him, even in the midst of the Tribulation. **KEY POINTS** 1. 7 Trumpets Will Be Blown The seven trumpets signal a new phase of judgment during the Tribulation. Each trumpet blast brings disasters, like destroying food supplies, polluting water, darkening the sun, and even unleashing spiritual torment. These events will shake the world and show the seriousness of sin and its consequences. God is using these judgments not just to punish but to wake people up and turn their hearts back to Him. Even though these trumpet judgments are terrifying, God's goal is still to give people a chance to change their ways. The pause before the trumpets is like a final warning, reminding us that God doesn't rush to judgment—He gives opportunities to repent. Sadly, many will ignore the warning and refuse to turn to God, showing how stubborn the human heart can be. This reminds us of the importance of choosing God today while we still have time.

God's Mighty Messengers

NOTES INTRODUCTION Revelation 11 reminds us that even when it looks like evil is winning, God's victory is certain. This chapter introduces two special messengers who boldly proclaim God's truth during the darkest times and show His power through their mission, death, and resurrection. **KEY POINTS** 1. Two Messengers Will Come God will send two witnesses to prophesy for 1,260 days, calling people to repentance and sharing the gospel. These messengers will be filled with the Holy Spirit, empowered to perform miracles, and protected by God until their mission is complete. Their courage and message will shine as a beacon of light in a dark and rebellious world. 2. Two Messengers Will Be Murdered When their mission is complete, the Antichrist will rise and kill these two witnesses. Their bodies will lie in the streets of Jerusalem for three and a half days as the world celebrates their deaths. This reaction reflects the hostility of a world that rejects God's truth and refuses to repent. 3. Two Messengers Will Be Resurrected After three and a half days, God will breathe life into the two witnesses, and they will rise to their feet as the world watches in shock and terror. They will ascend to heaven, proving God's power and sovereignty. This act will shake the world, causing some to give glory to God, realizing they were wrong to reject Him.
