



Sermon-Based GC Discussion Questions

2/22/2026

Title of Sermon: *Walk Where He Walks*

Main Point of Sermon: Walking with Jesus means leaving behind comfort, control, and certainty to embrace a new calling.

Launching Question:

- How has the idea of “following” someone been watered down in our day?

Primary Scripture: Matthew 4:18-21

Discussion Questions:

- Read 1 Corinthians 1:26-29. In Matthew 4, Jesus calls ordinary fishermen instead of religious elites. What does this reveal about how God chooses people?
- Read Luke 9:57-62. The disciples followed immediately. What stands out about their response compared to how people typically respond to Jesus today?
- Bonhoeffer said, “When Christ calls a man, he bids him come and die.” What does dying to self actually look like in modern life?
- Jesus says, “Follow me and I will make you...” What does this teach us about transformation versus self-improvement? (Read Philippians 1:6)

Application Questions:

- How are people tempted to admire Jesus instead of actually follow Him? How have you experienced this in your life?
- What “nets” (security, identity, comfort) might Jesus be asking you to loosen your grip on right now to follow Him more closely?
- Who is one person in your life you could intentionally move toward as a “fisher of men”?
- What is one concrete step you can take in the next 7 days to follow Jesus more fully?

Prayer Focus:

- Pray for Therefore International (missionaries Joey and Patti Romero) and their fundraising event that is this coming Saturday (remind your group about ways that they can serve)
- Ask God to reveal any “nets” you’re still clinging to and give you courage to surrender them.
- Ask God to put one specific person on your heart to pursue with love and gospel intentionality.
