

Sermon-Based GC Discussion Questions

9/15/2025

Title of Sermon: Step-in-Step: The Cadence of Christlikeness

Main Point of Sermon: Because God has made us one people in Christ, we must walk step-in-step with our church family in the cadence of Christlike humility, gentleness, patience, love, and unity.

Launching Question:

- Our world feels so divided right now—politically, socially, and even relationally. In the middle of that, why do you think unity in the church is such a powerful witness
- Ilf someone outside the church were to look at our relationships here, what do you think they would see that's different from the division and hostility in the world?

Primary Scripture: Ephesians 4:1-6

Discussion Questions:

- In verses 1–3, Paul connects "walking worthy" with humility, gentleness, patience, and bearing with one another. Why do you think Paul emphasizes relational virtues instead of individual disciplines here?
- What does Paul mean when he says we are to "maintain the unity of the Spirit" rather than create unity? How does that shape our role in the church?
- Why do you think Paul ties patience so closely to bearing with one another in love? How are those two virtues connected? (Compare with Colossians 3:12–14. What does this passage add about forgiveness and love?)
- How does Jesus' restoration of Peter (John 21) serve as a model for bearing with others in love?

Application Questions:

- When have you struggled to believe someone in the church could truly change? What does that reveal about your view of the Spirit's work?
- Think of a current relationship in our church that is strained. What would it look like to show humility in that relationship this week?
- Where do you find yourself being more patient with yourself than with others? What does that reveal about your heart?
- Are there people in the church you tend to avoid because they frustrate you? How might God be calling you to repent and pursue reconciliation?
- Unity requires eagerness and diligence. What specific step can you take to maintain the unity of the Spirit this week?



• Jesus bore with Peter and restored him. Who might God be calling you to bear with and walk toward restoration, rather than write off?

Prayer Focus:

- Pray for humility, gentleness, patience, and love to mark our community so that we walk worthy of our calling.
- Pray for grace to forgive, bear with, and believe the best about one another, even when relationships are hard.
- Pray that our Gospel Community would shine as a credible witness of Christ's love in a divided world.
